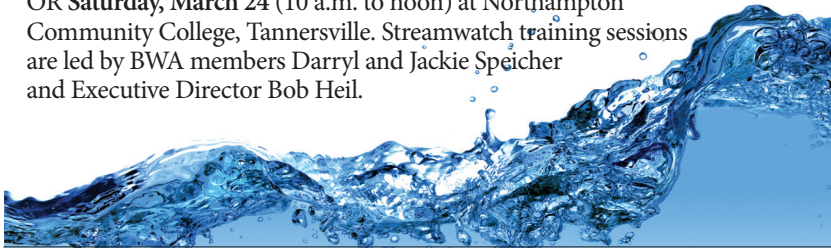
## BECOME A STREAMWATCHER
