BECOME A STREAMWATCHER

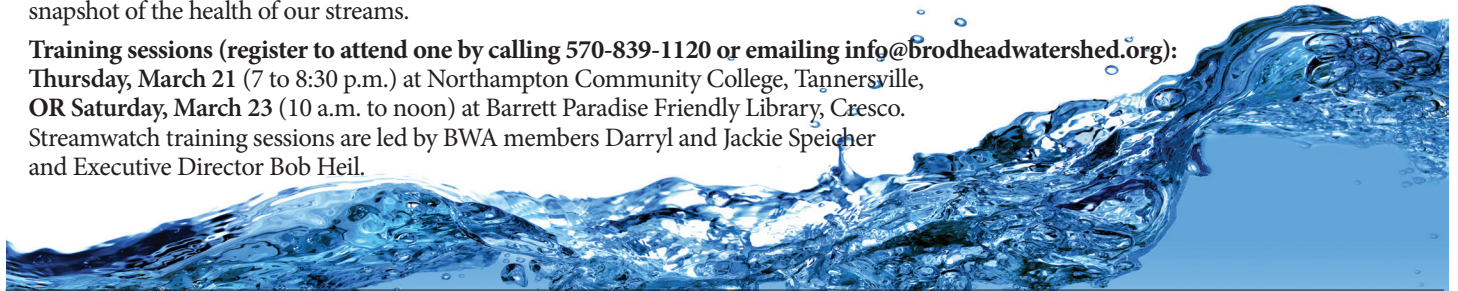
