- GREEN Nature Trail:** 1/2 mi. (easy)
- ORANGE Ruffed Grouse Trail:** 1/2 mi. (easy) • shortest path to Wilderness Camp
- BLUE Snowshoe Trail:** 1 mi. (moderate)
- PURPLE Wild Turkey Trail:** 1/4 mi. (easy) • link from Mountainside Lodges to Retreat Center
- WHITE Fox Run Trail:** 1/2 mi. (easy)
- RED Whitetail Trail:** 2 mi. (moderate)
- YELLOW Spruce Mountain Trail:** 2 mi. (difficult) • waterfalls and scenic overlook

All trail distances approximate. Please pack out ALL trash when hiking any trails.
