

Barrett holds a prestigious geographic position in the watershed as the source of the Brodhead Creek! In our own Barrett Township, the Middle Branch and the Leavitt Branch meet and the Brodhead Creek is born. It is soon joined by Buck Hill Creek and Goose Pond Run, Spruce Cabin Run and the Mill Creek all flowing through beautiful Barrett Township.

The community has shown its resolve to cherish and protect this magnificent natural resource. Through the open space program they have purchased property in the headwaters at Mount Wismer, The Gravel Family Preserve, and Chestnut Mountain. Then there is the Pasold farm Natural Preserve; a half mile stretch of the Brodhead Creek just south of Canadensis, that gives us all access to this beautiful stream as it spills over the sandstone shelves and cobble stones. These properties afford everyone outstanding opportunities to get outside and enjoy our home in a natural setting. The sound track for these outings during all seasons of the year is the rhythm of the Brodhead and her tributaries.
