Full Moon Over the Brodhead

Mount Wismer Nature Preserve Barrett Township, Rt 447 Sunday, July 21th at 7pm

Join local naturalist and Brodhead Watershed Native, Darryl Speicher, on Saturday evening, July 20, for a spectacular night hike on the Mount Wismer Nature Preserve in Barrett Township to view the Brodhead watershed under the light of the full moon. From our vantage point on the edge of the Pocono Plateau participants will be able to gaze across entire breadth of the Brodhead from the top of the Middle Branch all the way to the Delaware Water Gap. We will meet at the Mt. Wismer Preserve parking lot and start our hike at 7 pm. We will walk through the twilight, watch the moon rise and the stars come out. From our perch above the watershed we'll talk about the streams, the landmarks and the stars over head. The walk is moderately strenuous but don't let this deter you, the view is worth it! Mount Wismer is located on Route 447 approximately 5 miles north of the village of Canadensis, just before the Pike County line.
