PROJECT HEADWATERS - YANKEE RUN

Yankee Run is a small headwater tributary of Paradise Creek. It originates near the intersection of Routes 611 and 940, north of the Borough of Mt. Pocono. It was formerly the water source for the Fairview Water Company which supplied water to the Borough of Mt. Pocono for many years.

Samples were taken on land owned by Pocono Heritage Land Trust, formerly owned by Fairview Water Company. Sampling locations: approximately 50 yards downstream of Crestwood Drive (Yankee Run 1), on the stream where it bypasses the reservoir (Yankee Run 2), and from the spring which feeds the former reservoir (Yankee Run 3). Data collected in the field included electrical conductivity and chloride ion concentrations. Lab analyses were done for chloride, calcium, and sodium ion concentrations.

Results were compared to data collected by the Monroe County Water Quality Study in 2020 at 40 sites.
