
Lower Brodhead Streamwatch Snapshot- August 1, 2024



Volunteers collected temperature and conductivity data at 10 sites in the Lower Brodhead watershed on August 1, 2024, in the afternoon.

Temperature is shown in relation to trout health:



Conductivity is a measure of the ability of water to conduct electricity. Conductivity greater than 300 uS/cm is harmful to the aquatic insects trout feed on. Conductivity and chloride are closely related. The largest source of chloride in the Lower Brodhead watershed is deicing materials.
